### **"TAHOE RESIDENTS AND VISITORS, THERE ARE NO EVACUATIONS AT THE PRESENT TIME "**

- At this time the King Fire, originating in the Pollock Pines area, does not present an immediate danger to the Lake Tahoe Basin including Squaw Valley, Alpine Meadows, and Truckee.
- All local fire authorities and adjoining districts are cooperating and monitoring the progress of the King Fire.
- **There are no evacuation orders at this time in the Lake Tahoe Basin.**
- Despite rumors of proximity to the Lake Tahoe Basin, geographic obstacles cover a great deal of the area between the fire and the Lake Tahoe Basin.

- TTUSD is monitoring air quality and will make a determination on possible school cancellations tomorrow. Notice will be based on snow day schedule. All families will be notified by 6 a.m.
